Remember!

- Try splitting longer words into syllables to help you spell them.
- A closed syllable begins and ends with a consonant. The vowel in a closed syllable is usually short, as in each syllable of *napkin*.
- An open syllable ends with a vowel. The vowel in an open syllable is usually long, as in the first syllable of *music*.
