Remember!

- Use what you know to read words with trigraphs.
- Be on the lookout for digraphs like *sh, th,* and *ch*.
- When the letters dge appear together, they stand for the sound you hear at the end of the word bridge.

- When the letters sch appear together, they usually stand for the sound you hear at the beginning of the word scheme.
